



Journeys 360 Quick Start Guide For Educators

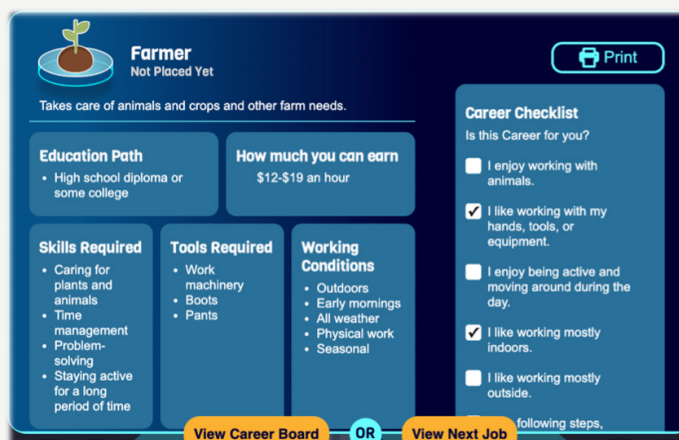
Journeys 360 is a game-based career exploration platform designed for students with and without disabilities in grades 7–12 (ages 13–22). Journeys 360 is designed to be student-led and self-paced. In the game, students “test-drive” 18 professions. Your role is to encourage career exploration and support student reflection throughout the experience.

It takes about 2–6 hours for students to complete the game. To reduce fatigue, we recommend students complete the game over multiple sessions.

Key Elements

Career Cards

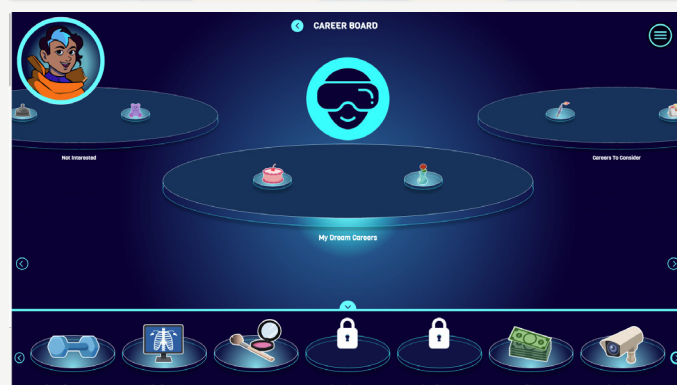
Students earn a Career Card after completing career simulation activities. Each card includes career information and a checklist.



Career Board

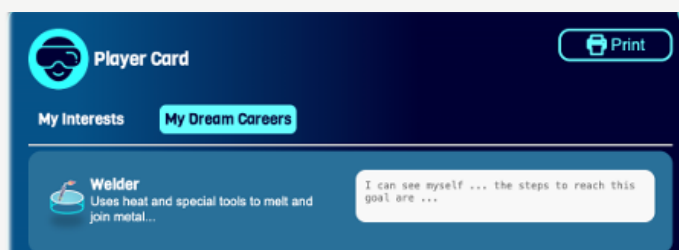
Students organize their cards on the Career Board into three categories:

1. not interested
2. my dream careers
3. careers to consider



Player Card

Students’ interests are automatically tracked as they organize Career Cards and complete checklists. As students identify their dream careers, there is a space to add notes to their Player Card.



Career Pathways

Journeys 360 careers are aligned with the Oklahoma Career Clusters and O*NET. Each pathway introduces students to related careers and helps them discover occupations that share similar skills and match their interests.
